FOREWARD

The table contained in this document provides a high-level overview as to where the countries and territories of Latin America and the Caribbean currently stand in terms of COVID-19 response measures. It addresses whether lockdowns and/or curfews are in effect, when such policies are slated to expire (if a particular date has been established), whether face masks are required in public, and whether non-essential businesses are currently open, closed, or in the midst of a phased reopening process. Links to government webpages that provide further information regarding COVID-19 and associated anti-infection measures have been included as well. The table will be revised and updated as circumstances continue to evolve.
